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It is located at a conveniently accessible location and is designed in a state-of-the-art manner. This outreach centre brings together the best of medical services under one roof.

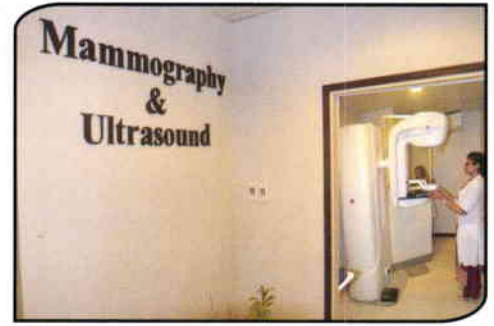
Services provided

This advanced dual headed gamma camera delivers superb image quality using scan times and doses as low as half that of the standard camera. It is equipped with a large gantry and table and is capable of handling patients upto 500 pounds. It has high quality detectors for better image quality and has the maximum capability to be customized according to patient's needs.
