

Introduction

Non-communicable diseases such as Diabetes, cardiovascular disease, CKD, cancers, respiratory and liver disease are the major cause of premature deaths especially in developing countries. According to WHO non communicable diseases accounts for 71 % of all

deaths globally. Prevention, screening and timely management of noncommunicable diseases by a trained Family physician/General practitioner can play a vital role in reducing the burden of NCDs mortality.

<u>Aim:</u>

This course aims to enhance the competencies of Family Physician/General Practitioner in prevention, evaluation and management of noncommunicable diseases in primary care.

Objectives:

- To improve knowledge about the modifiable risk factors of NCDs and their prevention strategies, including lifestyle modifications and pharmacotherapy.
- 2. To enhance skills in the early detection and diagnosis of NCDs, including the use of appropriate screening tools and diagnostic tests.
- To develop an understanding of the principles of management of NCDs, including updated Pharmacological and non-pharmacological management, and appropriate referrals to specialists.
- 4. To develop skills in the use of evidence-based guidelines and clinical decisionmaking tools in the management of NCDs.
- 5. To promote ongoing professional development in the field of NCDs for family physicians/ general practitioners.



Content:

Following topics will be covered in synchronous and asynchronous zoom sessions every week.

- → Management of Hypertension in primary care
- → Management of Diabetes Mellitus in Primary care
- → Management of stroke/TIA in primary care
- → Approach to chronic liver diseases in Primary care
- → Approach towards chest pain and ischemic heart disease
- → ECG Interpretation
- → Management of COPD /Asthma in primary care
- → Management of AKI/CKD/Proteinuria in primary care
- → Smoking cessation in Primary care

- → Consultation skills of a patient with diabetes
- → Consultation of a patient with chest pain
- → ECG interpretation quiz
- → Consultation skills for a patient with hypertension
- → Examination of a patient with suspected stroke/TIA

- → Insulin injection technique
- → Inhaler /revolizer/peak flow techniques
