

of Prof. Hafeez ul Hassan.



ADVANCED NURSING COURSE ON ENHANCING PATIENT CARE IN PAEDIATRIC SURGERY AND PAEDIATRIC UROLOGY PATIENTS

A comprehensive two-day Paediatric surgery workshop in collaboration with the department of nursing was carried out on 30 - 31 October 2023 at RSDC, LNH. The objective was to equip healthcare professionals with the skills and knowledge necessary to deliver optimal care to Paediatric surgery and Paediatric urology patients. This course covered an array of topics including the role of health care professionals in a Paediatric surgical setting. Participants were explained via lectures and demonstration of videos to understand the care of patients with surgical wound, urinary catheter, gastrostomy, chest tube, IV line and bowel and urinary stoma.





Participants learned both the theoretical and practical aspects and had a well-rounded learning experience. The hallmark of the course included hands-on training using advanced surgical equipment and techniques, allowing participants to practice and refine their skills.

In this workshop, we trained 26 participants, which included 7 Nurses of Paediatrics & Pediatric Surgery, 3 staff nurses from Civil Hospital, 1 from Virtual University and 15 BMST students. This includes the participation of personnel outside LNH as well. We received an overwhelming response from our participants and they were provided with a certificate of completion recognized by the organization.


LNH NEUROSURGICAL BOOT CAMP

The Department of Neurosurgery at Liaquat National Hospital, in collaboration with the WFNS Spine Committee and Pakistan Society of Neurosurgeons, organized the Neurosurgical Boot Camp 2023 on October 8. The event aimed to enhance the skills of young neurosurgeons and trainees through workshops and lectures. The boot camp condensed five years of neurosurgical training into a single day, focusing on basic surgical acumen, neurosurgical approaches, instrument handling, and treatment decision-making. Participants engaged in hands-on

sessions using spine and skull models, bovine brains for anatomu and microsurgical revision, training. The day started with talks on neurosurgical decision-making and controversies, including cervical trauma and degenerative spine conditions by Dr. Aamir Sagheer (LNH), Thoracolumbar fractures by Dr. Sagib (AKU), and management of spontaneous bleeds. Dr. Ehsan Bari (AKU) introduced brain tumors, while Dr. Atiq Ahmed (CHK) delved into spinal tumors. Dr. Farrukh (JPMC) resolved a controversy about



Degenerative Lumbar Disc. Dr. Mohsin (JMDC) discussed various cranial approaches. An interactive session on head injuries was led by Prof. Riaz Raja (LUMS). Practical sessions followed, with instruction on cranial approaches and instrument use by Dr. Saad Akhtar Khan and Dr. Manzar Hussain. A session on radiological interpretation by Dr. Tanveer (AKU), white matter anatomy and brain mapping with DTI by Dr. Shayan (AKU), MRI sequences in Brain and Spinal SOL by Dr. Shumaila (JPMC), and the role of stereotactic

radiosurgery in neurosurgery by Dr. Kamran (JPMC) were conducted. Dr. Naureen (AKU) presented the management of pediatric fourth ventricular tumors. Participants had the opportunity one-on-one interaction with mentors and engaged in case discussions. The event concluded with a questionnaire and certificate distribution. Overall, 707 nursing staff have been certified in MSN, 709 in CCN and 733 in maternal and child till date, along with nursing skills performance in collaboration with research and skills lab.



NES Specialization Courses

NURSING ORIENTATION PROGRAM

The Nursing orientation is a comprehensive program that aims to provide nurses with the knowledge, skills, and support they need to thrive in their roles and deliver high quality patient care. Overall, 52 participants were enrolled in a Nursing Orientation program held in the month of November and December 2023.

Covering a diverse range of crucial topics, the Nursing

Orientation Program addresses clinical procedures, patient assessment, medication administration, IV cannulation, infection control practices, nursing documentation, and communication skills. Employing a multifaceted approach involving classroom lectures, hands-on training, and practical experience, the program ensures that nurses acquire a robust foundation in these pivotal aspects of their profession.

HAND ON WORKSHOP FOR INTERMEDIATE MODULE EXAM (IMM) (MEDICINE)

A hand-on workshop for IMM (medicine) was arranged by the department of Internal Medicine on September 22 & 23, 2023. The two-day workshop comprises short cases and task-oriented assessment of clinical skills (TOACS) according to CPSP format. Interactive sessions on CT scan/ MRI, x-rays, ECG and pictures were conducted by the skilled professionals of respective fields. The theme and the efforts of conducting the workshop were highly appreciated by the candidates, and

it was also suggested that such courses should be conducted twice a year. At the end of the session, certificates were distributed to the entire team and participants.

NURSING - AART (ADVANCED ADULT RESUSCITATION TRAINING)

This newly designed Nursing - AART is a comprehensive certification program that not only integrates resuscitation training, performance improvement, critical procedures, and in-hospital patient safety initiatives but also employs a broad definition of "resuscitation" to include patient surveillance/monitoring, critical care, intra-arrest, and post-resuscitation care. In addition, Nursing - AART empowers health care providers of all disciplines by creating a "culture of resuscitation" that enhances patient safety.

This training is intended specially for nurses of critical care setups who need to promptly recognize and treat adult patients suffering from or at risk of cardiac arrest and other life-threatening emergencies, thereby improving their survival rates.

This is a 2 - day ongoing workshop developed by the nursing management committee and a team of experts. The course is conducted by consultants from teams of Cardiology, Anesthesiology, Neurology, RSDC and Nursing. A total of 188 participants were enrolled quarterly. Overall, 447 participants have successfully cleared this course till to date.

BRACHIAL PLEXUS PERIPHERAL NERVE REPAIR WORKSHOP ON 19TH NOVEMBER 2023 AT LUMHS (JAMSHORO)

The department of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery conducted a one-day cadaveric workshop in collaboration with Pakistan society of Neuro Surgeons at Liaquat University of Medical & Health Sciences (LUMHS, Hyderabad) on 19th November 2023 on brachial plexus.

At the workshop, the participants were given expert review on brachial plexus anatomy, mechanism of injury, examination and latest methods of repair of brachial plexus with outcome of procedures, followed by the detailed cadaveric dissection and discussion. Plastic surgeons from the Liaquat National Hospital supervised participants in the dissection and procedures and guiding practical points for management of brachial plexus injuries. Neurosurgery faculty from all over Pakistan attended the workshop, including the junior

consultants and residents of the neurosurgery.

STRESS MANAGEMENT

r. Iqtidar Taufiq and Dr. Kahkashan Tahir conducted a one-hour interactive "Stress Management" session for LNH interns. Fifty-nine interns took part, exploring facts, figures, and defining stress. 
